The 2002 angling year is history. What a year it was! What a November it was!! You might have thought that the fireworks were over after **Fred Murray** carded his big blue cat on 4-plug early in the month, but they weren't.

There was a mad scramble at the end of the month to get that last good fish. **Bob Shepherd** won that contest with a spectacular club record 3-14 rainbow trout on 2-fly that scored 516 points! Even though Fred's 1200-point catfish easily won the November angler of the month cup, Bob's trout won the war. He edged out yours truly to claim the 2002 C.V. Kinnard Angler of the Year award. **Fred Cousins** placed third in the monthly contest with a 35-0 red drum on 6-general that scored 466 points. There were six other entries in the final month's contest that scored 300 points or more! Congratulations to all for a great month and a great year!

Three new club records were added for striped bass in late November. **Stuart Lee** caught a 17-8 on 6 general and an 8-4 on 4 fly, while **Lynn Spurlin** netted a 15-0 on 20 fly. **Fred Cousins** caught a 5-13 club record crevalle jack on 2-spin at the "Hot Ditch". He also nabbed a 4-7 speckled trout on 2 general on a later trip. I managed a 9-0 little tunny release on 4-spin on a Harker's Island trip with **Glenn Sides**.

There was a flurry of freshwater entries at the end of the month. Lee Hall reservoir gave up several nice bass and pickerel. **Fred Cousins** released a 4-15 largemouth on 2-spin and I managed a 4-3. **Fred Murray** had the best pickerel with a 2-14 on 2-spin, followed by my 2-12 and Fred Cousin's 2-10. Elsewhere, on a private pond, **Kelly Stafford** released a largemouth on 4-plug that bottomed out his 6-pound scale. **Bob Shepherd** released a 4-6 smallmouth on 4-plug at the New River. **Eddy and Scott Johnston** continued their gar quests.

Eddy released an 11-2 on 2-spin and Scott claimed the 4-fly club record with a 10-14 gar. Finally, **Randy Matthews** was close, but not close enough. His 3-11 rainbow on 2-fly fell just short of Bob Shepherd's fish, but also beat the old record.

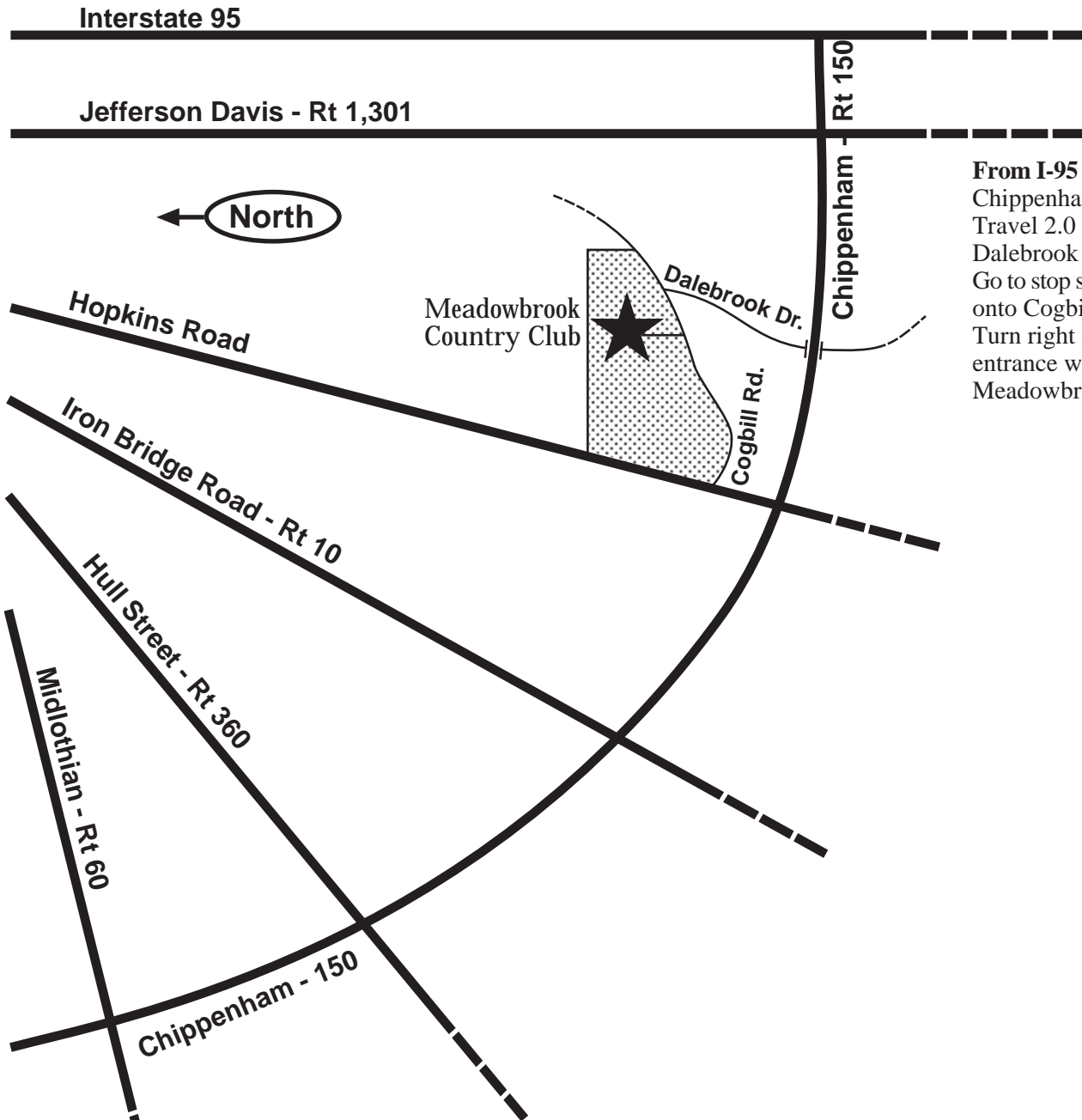
