## CATCHY COMMENTS

I hope the dog days are behind us and some cooler weather will improve the catching. The heat didn't discourage some from targeting the local, almost downtown, Flathead Catfish. Some of the catches included: **Tony Horsley** 18 lb. on 6 general, **Rob Brown** 17 lbs on 6 general, **Glenn Carter** 20 lbs. on 4 general, and **Bob Brown** 25 lbs on 6 general. It seems that **Bob Shepherd** was not convinced that you had to use to live bait to catch the Flathead Catfish and recorded a 21 lb. fish on 12 plug tackle.

Last year, the Angling Rules Committee established the Almaco Jack as a new club fish after **Elly Robinson** set a new IGFA record in 2006 for a 26 lb. 8 oz. fish. Previously, the Almaco was grouped in with his larger cousin the Amberjack. It seems that the Rules Committee knew what they were doing because last month we talked about **Buddy Noland's** potential IGFA world record 25.89 lb.

Almaco caught on 8 general off Hatteras. On August 23, **Bill DuVal** caught a 53 lb. 8 oz. Almaco while fishing off Bermuda on 20 lb general, which is also a potential IGFA world record. However, we also made the Blue-line Tilefish a new club fish, and there has been only a single entry to-date.

**Travis and Bruce Henderson** continued some productive outings off Hatteras with Travis's 36 lb. Barracuda and Bruce's released Amberjacks. Bruce reported that the Barracudas fed well over the winter because they are significantly larger than last year. **Parks Rountrey** fished with **Capt. Henderson** before the recent tropical storm and caught a 35 lb. Barracuda on 8 general worth 388 points.

**Lynn Spurlin** ventured to Destin, Florida and caught a 2 lb. 3 oz. Ladyfish on 6 spin. What a fun fish to catch; it's too bad we do not have enough of these fish to target in our local waters.

In their most recent publication, the IGFA clarified their rule on fly rod butt dimensions. For fly rods under 11 feet in length, the butt may not exceed 6 inches when measured from the center of the reel foot. For two-handed fly rods greater than 11 feet, the butt length may not exceed 10 inches.



## The Virginia Anglers Club Acts on Members' Comments

The Leadership Team and the Review Committee members wish to thank those members who took time and made the effort to give some feedback on the changes in the operation and programs of the club reported in the August *Angler*. To allow time for the suggestions to be turned into policy (changes in Angling Rules, etc.), the official comment period was closed at the end of the September 11, 2007 BOD Meeting.

At the September Board of Director's Meeting, collected comments were reviewed. As a result of the most frequently noted comment, the awarding of \$75 in cash to the Tournament Winners in the 2008 angling year was replaced with three award options available to the Tournament Winners. The choice will be between a \$75.00 Green Top Sporting Goods gift card, a suitable Tournament trophy and one club-provided banquet ticket to the Annual Awards Banquet. Other comments were discussed. No other changes were made in the suggestions previously adopted.

## Angler of the Month

There were only two entries made at the August meeting for Angler of the Month. **Glenn Carter** had an 18 lb. 8 oz. Flathead catfish on 4 general for 250 points for second place. **Parks Roundtre**y nosed him out with a 19 lb. Flathead on 4 general for 257 points.

## Changes in VAC By-Laws Authorized by the Board of Directors

Some changes in the By-Laws of the Virginia Anglers Club were authorized by the Board of Directors at the September 11, 2007 BOD Meeting. After motions and seconds for the changes were made, extensive discussions ensued. The authorization of the changes was by a unanimous vote (9-0) of the full Board of Directors.

A three step process, also authorized by the BOD, will be followed that will end with a vote to be held at the November Membership Meeting. The first step will be the presentation for approval of the exact text of the changes to the Directors at the October BOD Meeting. The second step is the printing in the October Angler of the text of the changes as approved by the BOD. Finally, those members having a vote and who are present at the November 27<sup>th</sup> Membership Meeting will be requested to show their approval or disapproval by a show-of-hands vote of each individual change authorized by the Board in October. A two-thirds vote of members eligible and present to vote is needed to change any By-Law.

The major change authorized was to remove the word "male" from Article III, Memberships, Section 2 of the By-Laws. Other minor changes authorized were correction of typographical errors in the By-Laws and addition of some verbiage from Robert's Rules of Order so that the By-Laws become more complete in certain areas. These minor changes will be printed in the October Angler.

The major change that removes "male" from the Membership section was thoroughly discussed at the September BOD Meeting with all 9 members of the Board present. It was noted that, in the past, this change in the By-Laws had been voted down on at least three occasions. The Board Members felt the beliefs of the majority of Club members have now changed from a historical exclusionary belief to a belief that would embrace the opportunity to create an open membership. Further, the BOD felt that if public exposure of the VAC is increased via a "splash page" or a web site of some type, the Club could be embarrassed by public awareness of an exclusionary membership requirement. Finally, some members are known to be at risk in their personal employment if they are identified with being part of a club with membership exclusions. Thus the Board Members adopted this amendment to the By-Laws.

Three methods of voting to be used at the November Membership Meeting were discussed by the BOD. The Board approved voting by counting a show-of-hands vote. This method aligns with Robert's Rules of Order and the Club By-Laws. Voting by secrete ballot and the option to register a vote via a requested absentee ballot were not approved.

Please study the texts of the exact amendments to the By-Laws when they are published in the October Angler.



### Escatawba Farms

Escatawba Farms is a farm located near Covington, Va on Dunlap Creek. It is blessed with a beautiful, well maintained Trout stream. Derrick Barr stocks the stream with Rainbows, Brook, and Brown trout. The trout are stocked several times a year, and not each day as some trout farms do. Once stocked, these trout must live on the forage base present in the stream, which makes fly fishing very more enjoyable. In the past trips taken to Escatawba by the VAC, fish sizes ranged from 1 to 3 lbs. Anglers can expect to catch from 15-30 fish, depending on your level of skill. Escatawba is a great place for the beginner Fly Fisherman, as every condition you will find on a trout stream is present, riffles, pools, rapids, etc. There are also 3 ponds that are stocked. If you are a beginner fly fisherman, you will have plenty of fellow anglers to instruct you.


### How to get to Escatawba


