Out of the current one hundred and two members of the Virginia Anglers Club, he had the ninth oldest membership. Ray was a saltwater angler with the surf being his favorite "fishing hole". Ray was a quiet but serious angler. His submissions were all saltwater species.

When Ray retired, he moved down to Rodanthe, NC. Ray would come up to Richmond every year to have his scales certified at the February Membership Meeting, usually in the company of VAC Member and best friend, Everett Spence.




Andy's presentation "A Googans Guide to Fly Fishing Colorado" explained his adventures and specifics of fishing in the beautiful state of Colorado. His first visit was in 2008 fishing the Frying Pan River for Cut bows and Brown Trout. He recommended calling a local fly shop before you arrive for fish information and water conditions. Also fishing with a local guide for tips on local waters.

Other recommendations:

- Fish Late Spring/Early Summer
- Primetime Late Summer/Early Fall
- Winter Primary Tail Water Fishing
- Avoid Spring Runoff (Snow Melt)
- Call about Stream Conditions

What to bring: Maps, Printed Directions, Fishing License (\$37 for 5 days), Cameras, Appropriate Clothing, Sunglasses, Waders & Boots, Backpack, and Fishing Equipment.

You can get a direct flight from Richmond to Denver, rent a car and drive 1.5 to 3 hours to great Rivers, lakes, and Reservoirs. Andy thanks for sharing your experiences with the membership!





VAC SURF TEAM REPORT - 2019 CAPE HATTERAS ANGLERS CLUB INVITATIONAL SURF TOURNAMENT



On the first day of the Cape Hatteras Anglers Club Invitational Surf Tournament, the VAC Surf Fishing Team fished in good weather. The mornings' catch of 6 sea mullet garnered 13 points and the afternoon session yielded a mix of sea mullet and blues (six fish in all) for 18 points. The Team finished in 39th position out of 120 teams in the morning session. Position scoring was not complete for the end of the afternoon session when the day's report was received from Team Member Buddy Noland. Each fishing session started with a toast to the memory of Ray Nuckols who pulled lines a little over two weeks ago.

Fishing tomorrow's two sessions will be challenging because of the forecast weather. Below is the current weather report* from the NWS for Buxton on Friday. Rain can be tolerated but check out the wind forecast! The surf will run along the beach and lots of lead will be needed to begin to hold the bottom.

The second day's report from the VAC Surf Fishing Team fishing in the 2019 Cape Hatteras Anglers Club Invitational Surf Fishing Tournament.

The VAC Surf Team had pretty decent stations on Friday, both in the morning and afternoon. However, Friday's weather made fishing at these two stations miserable at best.

During the Friday morning session, the wind blew 25 to 45 MPH. Winds this strong cause the surf to run parallel to the beach. Terminal tackle did not hold bottom and was swept down the beach. No fish were caught during the morning session.

The afternoon station had the team fishing with the wind on their backs. The problem with this station was dirty water which stretched from the beach out as far as team members could see. One blue was caught that yielded only 5 points.

The VAC Surf Team placed 36th out of the 120 teams registered for the tournament. Their total qualifying catch was 13 fish worth 36 points.

Team Members were Buddy, Danny and Ryan Noland, Jeff Doughty and Fred Cousins. Team Member Kenny Dale had to withdraw at the last moment due to illness in his family. Thanks, guys, for keeping the Virginia Anglers Club's name in this popular annual tournament.


