MAY PROGRAM REPORT



Stuart Lee presented on his experiences of years fishing for Speckled trout. He has fished for Speckled trout since 1977 in Virginia & North Carolina. Mostly Stuart prefers North Carolina primarily between Oregon Inlet and Hatteras. The presentation provided Speckled trout data, how to, and tackle needed. These topics will be separated below:



Data:

- A Speckled trout will grow one pound a year.
- Since 1999 there have been 7 bad winter kills, followed by a poor fishing year.
- Stuart has found N.C. having more Specs and Virginia having larger fish.
- The top 3 things found in a Specs stomach:
 - o Pigfish
 - o Shrimp
 - o Crabs
- Speckled trout is Stuart's favorite eating fish and they freeze well.

How to:

- Stuart likes to look for areas that are half grass and half sand in 4 to 5 foot of water.
- He prefers fishing from an anchored boat instead of drifting.
- For best results retrieve your lure with the current, if your boat is anchored do not forget to cast in the seam behind the boat against the current.
- The Southwest wind is ideal, and a strong Northeast could drop the water by 10 degrees. Check the previous days winds before you fish.
- Specs do not feed all the time, change locations multiple until you find the bite.

Tackle:

- Stuart prefers a stiff 6-foot rod with a popping cork and grub.
- The leader 15lb fluorocarbon 36 – 38 inches and 3/8oz jig head with a larger hook.
- He uses 4-inch grubs in different colors.
- Very important, make sure the grub body is straight on the hook shaft.
- Fly fishing a 6wt rod, with intermediate line, and a 3.5-inch clouser fly multiple colors with flash.

Our members have their specialties, like Stuart and specks. I immediately think of Eddy Johnston and longnose gar. Eddy is so gracious when asked about longnose gar and willing to help you understand how the fish acts and how catch them. You can get a leg up on your next trip by checking out VAC's online catch database. Johnny Wetlaufer put in long hours taking our history of catches and creating the VAC's digital catch database. He's made it very easy to find species specific catch data so the next time you are after a sunfish, or flounder check it out and you might see the same members name over and over on that specie and would be the person to reach out to. It's all about communication and members should use this tool, including new members ... don't be shy when it comes to asking questions.

Josh Dolin and Glenn Carter will be teaming up to make a series of videos on Virginia Anglers Club new member orientation. The current COVID situation has sped up this project with the inability to meet face to face. It will offer new members and current members alike an opportunity to learn or relearn the rules of the club through the incredible presentation skills (and knowledge) of Master Angler Glenn Carter, and the superb filming skills of Josh. Chickahominy Lake Expedition Report


The Virginia Anglers Club expedition on the Chickahominy Lake set out from Ed Allen's Boats and Bait and from Eagle's Landing on Saturday (6/6/2020). Water temperatures were in the high 70's in the main lake in the morning, ranging into the middle to high 80's in the shallows by mid-afternoon. The lake level was a few inches above the top of the dam, and the water was medium brown

and slightly turbid in the lower lake. The weather was sunny with scattered clouds and relatively light winds, a beautiful day but a bit on the warm side. Bluegills were recovering from a series of heavy thunderstorms the night before, but some larger bluegills and a few shellcrackers were in loose spawning clusters near the banks into 1 to 4 feet of water, while smaller bluegills interspersed with a scattering of other species were randomly scattered along shorelines. Jerry Davis and Art Conway released 43 bluegills, 3 shellcrackers, and 2 bass, almost all on flyrods. Mike Ostrander and Lynda Richardson caught 7 nice bass plus a mix of other species. Jarad Mitchell and his Dad caught a nice yellow perch. The kayak contingent of Carter Clevinger, Terry Midkiff, and his son caught Bass, Gar, and bluegills. Most of the participants assembled in the Lakeside Restaurant for lunch after a really fun day.



FOR SALE



I have a 10wt Sage fly rod with reel and line that I bought new in 2009, and I will never use them. I test/practiced casted with them on the lawn a few times when new, but I never used them. They have never been on/in water. This, they are in absolutely new condition. They have been stored in a closet this entire time, and have no mold, dirt, or any such. In the following paragraphs I will describe the individual items.

The rod is a Sage Xi 2, 1090-4, #10 line, 9'0", 4 1/2 oz. I bought it from Cabela's for \$532.50.

The reel is a Ross Momentum GLD 6. I bought it from Cabela's for \$275. I have the original brand-new condition box with warranty card, etc.

The line is Scientific Anglers Mastery Series Quad Tip Saltwater, WF-10-F/S Green. The tips are as follows. 15' AST Floating. 15' Type I clear tip (1.5 - 2 ips). 15' Type III Wet Tip (3-5 ips). 15' Type V Wet Tip (6-8 ips). The line to tip connections are built in loop to loop. It has a "breathable mesh quad compartment wallet." I have the original box with spool in it. I bought the line, tips, and wallet as a one item set, from Cabela's for \$139.95.


