**Angler Dies after Water Rescue Near Hart-Miller Island**

August 1, 2020

A 61-year-old man died Saturday evening after being pulled from the water near Hart-Miller Island, where Middle and Back rivers meet the Bay.

Maryland Natural Resources Police (NRP) say the man was fishing with a friend on a 14-foot v-hull boat around 5 p.m. when it capsized in rough waters. The man's friend was able to swim to shore, but the victim was not.

Marine Emergency Team 21, a volunteer marine fire/rescue group, say they deployed rescue swimmers and organized bystanders to help with the shallow-water search.

A witness named Adam, who was among the dozens of boaters at Hart-Miller Island that afternoon, helped in the search. He tells Bay Bulletin the water was about four feet deep in the area. He says a chain of people walked the area and recovered the victim.

When the man was found and brought aboard the fire rescue boat, he was in critical condition. The North Point Edgemere VFD helped transfer the victim to shore where a Baltimore County Fire Department paramedic rushed him to the hospital. He died about an hour and 15 minutes later, NRP say.

Police are awaiting autopsy results and continue to investigate the accident.





## EXPEDITIONS

### Small Boat – Kayak – Wade fishing Expedition at Mill Creek on September 12th

The expedition will take place in Hampton Va. with target species being Speckled Trout. This area will get very busy this time of the year. The small parking lot for the wade fishermen will fill up early, once parked walk over the short bridge to the circle on the map. The additional parking lot is available, and we can ferry people to the bridge.

The kayakers have two options, there is a kayak launch and a boat ramp. The boat ramp is okay for small boats to launch. The parking for the boat ramp is in the additional parking lot.

We will be fishing the outgoing tide on Sept 12th high tide is 5:02 am and low tide is 11:14 am. The sunrise is at 6:45 am, so I recommend getting there at 6:15 am and fish until 11ish. There is a restaurant the Deadrise at Old Point Comfort marina near the boat ramp we can meet for lunch, great seafood and burgers. After lunch you can fish the incoming tide!

Remember to fish with light line 6# test or less to accumulate points and turn in the e-cards! Species that will be available Speckled Trout, puppy drum, and flounder.

From Richmond (1 hour 20min) take I-64 East to Exit 268 Mallory St/Ft Monroe, Take a left at the light on S Mallory St, Take a right on E Mellen St, Go about 3 blocks and the small parking lot will be on your left (Wade Parking), Drive over the bridge at the light take a right on McNair Dr, additional parking will be on your left, the boat ramp will be on your right. An address for the Deadrise and boat ramp 100 McNair Dr Hampton VA, 23651.

# FOR SALE



I have a 10wt Sage fly rod with reel and line that I bought new in 2009, and I will never use them. I test/practiced casted with them on the lawn a few times when new, but I never used them. They have never been on/in water. This, they are in absolutely new condition. They have been stored in a closet this entire time, and have no mold, dirt, or any such. In the following paragraphs I will describe the individual items.

The rod is a Sage Xi 2, 1090-4, #10 line, 9'0", 4 1/2 oz. I bought it from Cabela's for \$532.50.

The reel is a Ross Momentum GLD 6. I bought it from Cabela's for \$275. I have the original brand-new condition box with warranty card, etc.

The line is Scientific Anglers Mastery Series Quad Tip Saltwater, WF-10-F/S Green. The tips are as follows. 15' AST Floating. 15' Type I clear tip (1.5 - 2 ips). 15' Type III Wet Tip (3-5 ips). 15' Type V Wet Tip (6-8 ips). The line to tip connections are built in loop to loop. It has a "breathable mesh quad compartment wallet." I have the original box with spool in it. I bought the line, tips, and wallet as a one item set, from Cabela's for \$139.95.
