2022 VAC Angling Rule Changes

The Angling Rules Committee presented the new rule changes to the Board of Directors. The rule changes are based on input from VAC club members. The BOD has approved the rule changes and they will go into effect beginning with the 2022 angling year

- 1) Add fall fish to the freshwater basic weight table (see attached);
- 2) Remove striped bass (saltwater) from consideration for awards starting 12/1/21 until the Angling Rules Committee deems the fishery has recovered.
- 3) Eliminate the J.P. Pajchak award for billfish releases.
- 4) Eliminate the C.V. Kinnard Angler of the Month / Angler of the Year awards; and
- 5) Replace the current basic weights for Gar with the attached revised basic weights.

2021 VAC Surf Fishing Tournament Results

The best way to sum up the 2021 Hatteras Anglers Club surf tournament was the old saying, “you should have been here yesterday”. Our first day stands were poor, and we only managed 2 scoreable fish. We caught a lot of small undersized fish. When first day scores were posted that night, the stand that gave up the highest amount of points, was our third round location Friday morning. So, we were excited, same stand, same high tide, same 25 knot NE wind in our face, nothing to make the fish move. The judge tells me how lucky we were, that we had the stand that the most first round points were scored on, plus his 10 stands he judged scored over 600 points the first day. Many of those teams were in top 10 first day results. I think that is what you call “the kiss of death”. At the end of the third round, we had zero score able fish. His 10 stands that scored over 600 points the day before scored 6 points, one team caught 2 bluefish five minutes before the end of the round. That’s what is meant by “ should have been here yesterday”. The next group of stands about 5 miles down the beach caught bluefish and puppy drum, same location that teams zeroed out the day before, I guess that’s where our fish went.. The VAC team fished hard the entire tournament but had our worst finish since the Halloween Storm years ago, when we fished in 50 knot winds for two straight days.



Former VAC Member Steve, Hutchins Pulls Lines in December 2021


Former Virginia Anglers Club Member Steve Hutchins pulled lines in early December 2021. Steve is likely remembered more by Members of long standing than by most of the current membership. Steve was an active Member from the mid-seventies into the nineties. Steve was the owner of Mobility Printing and retired to Manteo, NC, taking up residence on Ballast Point in the Pirates Cove community and marina.

Steve was among the many VAC Members that went to the Gulf Stream in small center console boats powered by outboard motors. Steve’s first boat of many bearing the name Razmatazz was a Sea Craft center console. In those days, offshore fishing by Members was primarily done out thru Oregon Inlet, NC.

Steve was a prolific catch entry card submitter. He submitted 155 total cards. All but two were for saltwater catches. One hundred thirty-eight were for billfish (55 whites, 41 blues and 42 sails). Steve fished in the waters of VA, MD, NC, FL and in non-domestic waters including Bermuda, Mexico and Costa Rica. Steve’s 153 saltwater catch entries include 13 Club Records that still stand to this day.

There will be no obituary nor memorial service for Steve. Lines out, Steve, for the last time. You will be well remembered by those of us who knew you and admired by all for your angling accomplishments.




DO YOU KNOW THE DIFFERENCE?

Alabama bass (invasive)



Largemouth bass



- Anglers are reminded that the introduction of novel predators can have unforeseen impacts on native or established ecosystems.
- The introduction of Alabama bass is illegal in Virginia. Alabama bass have been scientifically shown to out-compete established populations of largemouth bass and hybridize with small-mouth bass.
- Invasive species cause negative ecological and/or economic harm.
- Anglers who suspect they have captured an Alabama bass should take a picture of the fish, clip off a thumbnail-sized portion of one of the pelvic fins, and store the fin clip dry in an envelope. The pelvic fins are located on the bottom of the fish, just under the head. They should then either contact the Department of Wildlife Resources at: fisheries@dwr.virginia.gov or 804-367-1293.
