Saltwater Conservation & Legislation

From Chris Dollar Saltwater Conservation & Legislation Chair

1. **Cobia:** In February, VMRC voted to replace the Recreational Cobia Mandatory Reporting Program with the Voluntary Recreational Cobia Initiative, and VMRC Staff is looking to collect the following length data from recreational anglers. Read More: <u>https://www.vasaltwaterjournal.com/index.php?msg=3</u>

- Released cobia under 40 inches
- Cobia over 50 inches if a 50-plus inch fish has already been harvested
- Cobia caught after the daily allowed bag limit has been reached,
- Cobia caught pre- and post-season.

2. **Rockfish/Stripers:** At its May meeting, the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission (ASMFC) Striped Bass Management Board exercised a <u>seldom-used emergency action</u> intended to reduce fishing mortality in the striped bass fishery with the goal of increasing the chances of rebuilding the population to the biomass target by 2029.

The emergency action implements a 31-inch maximum size limit across the entire recreational fishery in Chesapeake Bay and along the coast by July 2, 2023. Almost all states have complied already. The minimum size limit, bag limit, seasons and gear restrictions will remain unchanged. The Board also initiated Addendum II that will consider a more thorough management change using the formal public input process for implementation in 2024.

The Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission has scheduled tentative virtual meetings of the Atlantic Striped Bass Management Board, Interstate Fisheries Management (ISFMP) Policy Board and the full Commission to review compliance with the <u>emergency action</u> taken by the Atlantic Striped Bass Management Board on May 2, 2023. These meetings will be held via webinar on July 5 from 1 – 3 PM in the event that any state or jurisdiction fails to implement the required 31-inch maximum size limit for striped bass recreational fisheries by July 2 Read More: <u>https://ccavirginia.</u> <u>org/new-striped-bass-regulations-aimed-at-addressing-conservation-concerns/</u>

3. **Speckled Trout:** No word on proposed/ possible VMRC changes to the Commonwealth's speckled (spotted) trout regulations. NC DMF held public hearings to solicit input on the FMP & because it is a "share stock" between the two states VMRC said they'd also hold public meetings but they have not nor did not.

NC Division of Marine Fisheries latest Spotted Seatrout stock assessment has determined that the stock is not overfished but overfishing is occurring (Catching more fish faster than the stock can replenish). NC-DMF is mandated by state statute to end overfishing within two years, to do so the NC-DMF will need a reduction in total removals of speckled trout between 14.6-39.6%.

4. **Menhaden Lawsuit:** The VSSA Board of Directors (which VAS is a member) voted to not support the lawsuit filed against VMRC on behalf of the Southern Maryland Recreational Fishing Organization. Litigants claim VMRC has failed to properly manage the menhaden population in state waters. VAC decided not to join the lawsuit and follow the lead of the VSSA for now.

Cedar Springs Trout Farm Expedition Dec 17-19th

Are you looking for a great way to close out the 2023 fishing year? Want to join us for a very Merry Fishmas? Look no further than the Virginia Anglers Club expedition to **Cedar Springs Trout Farm**!

From Sunday December 17th to Tuesday December 19th, the club has reserved the Sportsman's Lodge, the Farmhouse, and the Bunkhouse for a great fishing trip.

Cedar Springs Trout Farm has been in operation since 1954 and offers 2 miles of fishable stream on Cripple Creek. The stream is stocked daily with Rainbow, Brown, Brook, and Golden Trout that are 2 lbs. and up. This is a great place to catch a freshwater leaping fish on spin, plug, or fly tackle. Every year we catch a pile of citation trout.

A Virginia Fresh water license is required, but no trout stamp is needed. You are allowed to catch and keep 6 fish per day per person, so this is not a catch and release trip. The cost for two nights stay man's Lodge, the Farmhouse and the bunk house all have nice accommodations. Linens are provided. There is a phone at the lodge - cell phones may not **get a**

good signal. We will meetup at Cedar Springs at or around 4:00 pm on December 17th and will stay overnight on the 17th and 18th. We will have dinner/ supper together on Monday and will have lunch and breakfast foods for two days. Cost for food will be determined once we are close enough to the expedition to make plans.

Come join us for this great trip! Not only will you get to enjoy some great fishing, but you'll also get to spend time with your fellow anglers. Don't miss out on this opportunity to close out the 2023 fishing year with the Virginia Anglers Club!




Cape Hatteras Surf Trip with hosts Danny and Buddy Noland June 3rd

DWR RECEIVES MUSKIE FINGERLINGS FROM NORTH CAROLINA

RICHMOND, VA- the Department of Wildlife Resources (DWR) picked up nearly 22,000 3-inch muskie fingerlings from North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission's (NC WRC) Table Rock Fish Hatchery. These fish will be used to meet annual stocking allocations across Virginia. About 14,000 of the fish were stocked into a rearing pond at the Buller Fish Hatchery where they will be grown out to advanced fingerling size, which is approximately 10 inches.

An additional 3,000 fingerlings were taken to the newly renovated Front Royal Hatchery for growout to advanced fingerling size. The advanced-sized fish will be stocked this fall. The remainder of the 3-inch fingerlings were stocked in existing muskie waters according to DWR's Muskellunge Management Plan. These bonus fish should help to enhance the muskie fishing opportunities in Virginia in the coming years.

This abundance of muskie fingerlings was made possible through an ongoing cooperative effort between DWR and NC WRC. In February of this year, DWR collected seven adult muskie from the lower New River. These fish were taken to the NC WRC's hatchery for spawning and the fingerlings received this week are from that February collection effort. All muskie stocked into Virginia over the last several years are a result of this ongoing cooperation with North Carolina.






