Tournament Results

Oak Orchard River October 20-25

Upstate New York was beautiful with the fall colors at their peak. We had some cold rain one day and snow flurries another but otherwise the weather was good. Unfortunately, I was the only club member on the trip but good friend Ray Moyer and I somehow survived by fishing eight hours per day and eating far too much food each night. From what we heard fishing had been a bit slow on the Oak Orchard the week before we arrived but we enjoyed good numbers of fresh Chinook Salmon and a few Brown Trout. The only down side of the Oak Orchard is the number of fishermen and they were out in force and in one of my favorite spots! Ray and I each landed salmon up to around twenty pounds and accidentally foul hooked many more; landed a couple of Browns and I had a brief encounter with a nice steelhead.

We had agreed before the trip to scout out some other tributary streams to see if we could get away from the crowds. I must say on the second day we lucked into one large pool on a stream loaded with BIG browns and no anglers. They were incredibly spooky but I finally did manage to hook one on perhaps the fiftieth cast on a stone fly nymph. I yelled for Ray and told him I thought I had a good fish hooked up. After a few minutes we got our first look at the brown that was fighting deep in the large pool. Ray declared the fish wasn't one of the big ones we had seen earlier and I had to agree but the fish would not give up. After a long fight on the six-pound tippet we managed to net the trout and it weighed 12 _ lbs! As I said the fishing was very tough but I did managed to hook (and break off) a couple of true monsters in the next few days. Those big browns seem to be able to find logs to go under when hooked. The light tippets required to get them to hit just would not stop them. I did manage to land one better fish that weighed 13lbs, my personal best, but I still have memories of a couple browns that were likely pushing twenty pounds! Sorry you folks missed it. Upcoming Angling Events

Rockfish Tournament December 7 & 8, 2002

Location: Norview Marina/Chesapeake Bay

Time: Dawn to Dusk each day

Awards: 1 "Jungle Rules" Cup for heaviest Rockfish that can be caught on any legal tackle; wire etc. (This might be what you want to use for the first day with the "money on the line" in the CCA tournament) 1 cup will also be awarded for the highest point Rockfish. You may want to consider using light tackle on Sunday for a high points VAC fish.

Note: If you are participating in the CCA tournament your fish will also be eligible in the VAC tournament.

Weigh-In: Call Glenn with in 5 days to register your catches.

VAC Surf Fishing Tournament December 14 & 15, 2002

Location: Surf line from NC state line north of Duck to NC state line with SC

Time: Daylight on the 14th to sunset on the 15th

Awards: 1 cup for the largest striper caught from the surf (jungle rules apply).
1 cup for the highest point total for three eligible VAC recognized species caught from the surf.

Lynn's Tips: Use live eels/cut bunker around the mouth of Oregon Inlet for stripers. Walk over the dunes on Pea Island NWR south of Oregon Inlet and fish for specks, stripers and bluefish. Specks may be caught in sloughs around some of the Nags Head area piers with green grubs/Fin S lures. Larger bluefish have been scarce near the beach but sometimes are mixed with schools of stripers.
