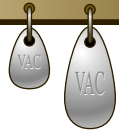

CATCHY COMMENTS by Danny Noland



One interesting part of being the keeper of the VAC catch entries is always knowing who is catching what, when and how. I can recall, when I was the record keeper several years ago, sitting in a membership meeting and looking around the room and counting 14 anglers that were current IGFA World Record Holders. You were in awe of the angling expertise that was assembled in one angling club. Now, that I am once again the receiver of the club catch entry cards, and seeing the drop in volume of cards being

turned in compared to years ago, I once again look around the room at the membership meeting, but this time, I am wondering if any of these guys could even catch a **COLD**, much less a decent fish. Finally, some of our anglers have started restoring my faith in their ability to catch a fish with the saltwater fishing starting to heat up.

I knew it was a matter of time before **Eddie Johnston** would slip out to his Gar hole on the James River and his entry of a 9-8 Gar on 2# general for 276 points won the Angler of the Month award for June. **Fred Cousins** took 2nd place with a 17-0 Flathead Catfish on 4# general for 230 points and **Fred** also took 3rd place with a 17-0 Blue Catfish on 2# general for 209 points. **Eddie's** gar and **Fred's** flathead took over the lead for these specie. **Fred's** 2nd and 3rd place entries boost his lead for the **Angler of the Year** award with 1771 points.

Bill Duval had three great days of fishing in Key West in late April. These entries failed to make the newsletter during the transition of record keeping. **Bill** had eight VAC club records, with one entry being a potential IGFA world record. **Bill** started off day one with three Blackfin tuna entries, a 24-8 on 12#plug for 350 points, a 22-0 on 16# plug for 244 points, an a 22-0 on 20# fly for 220 points. The second day produced a 5-0 Red Snapper on 6# general for 128 points, then a 9-12 Red Grouper (Grouper, other) on 8# general for 240 points. This Grouper is a potential line class world record. **Bill's** third day of fishing finished his assault on the club record sheets with a 17-8 Mutton Snapper on 16# general for 194 points, a 14-8 Mutton Snapper on 20# general for 136 points and a 24-0 permit on 8# general for 300 points. The Florida waters also produced a Tarpon release for **Bill Carter** on 4# general for 500 points. I know there were several other club members that tried the Florida and Costa Rica waters, but I haven't had the reports from them as of this newsletter. **Scott Johnston** tried the Piankatank River again and took a specie leading 1-11 Croaker on 2#fly for 281 points.

Elly and **Robbie Robinson** wreck fished with **Bruce Henderson** for a couple of days out of Hatteras. Fishing conditions were poor, but **Elly** had an outstanding catch of a 29-8 Barracuda on 6# plug for 458 points, which took over the Saltwater plug division. **Bruce** found a weed line, from which they were able to pull some gaffer dolphin off of, with **Robbie** having the best catch of a 13-8 on 6# general for 225 points.

Buddy Noland fished the waters off Va. Beach and caught a 6-6 Flounder on 6# plug for 318 points and a new club record.

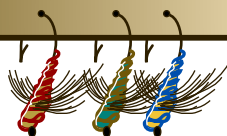

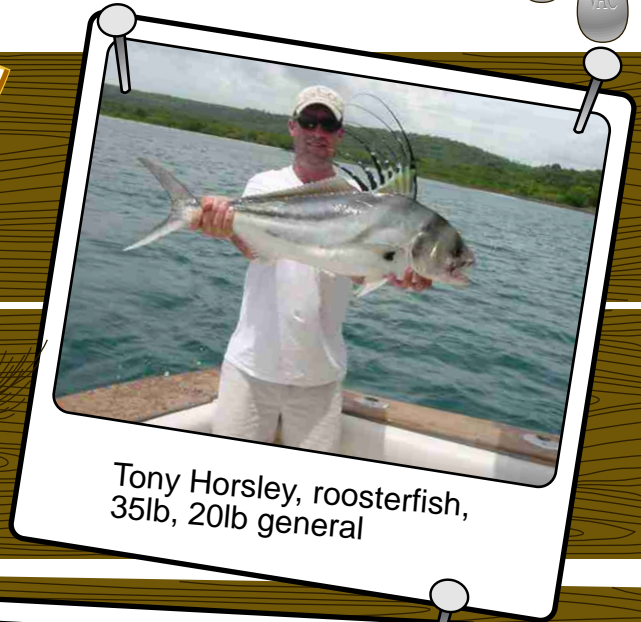

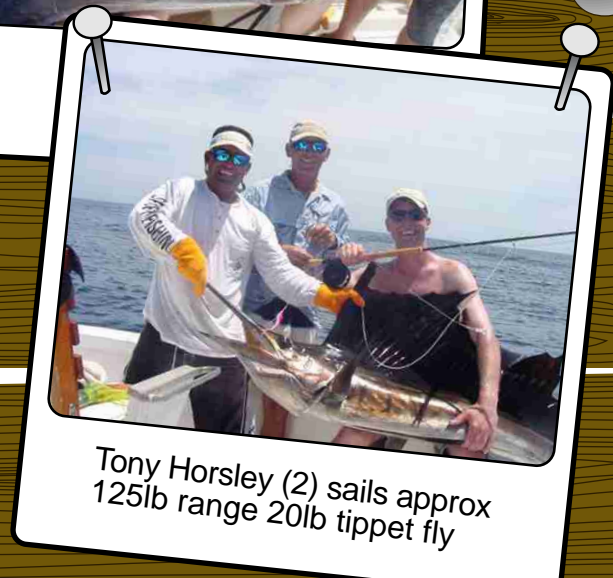
