Fiscal 2006 Ends With The Club Meeting Budget Forecasts

A projection of known expenses and income between the November Board of Directors Meeting and the end of November indicates that income will lag expenses by about only \$30. This Club's 2006 budget was \$11,400. The Board receives the monthly treasurer's report at their monthly meeting.

Dues Are Due Beginning December 1, 2006

Membership dues are due and payable on December 1, 2006. There has been no increase in dues for 2007. Active Members residing in-state pay \$60.00 per year and active members residing out-of-state pay \$40.00 per year. Life and Honorary Members pay no dues. Dues may be paid by check made out to The Virginia Anglers Club and mailed to or handed to Treasurer Fred Cousins. Cash works very well also.

Virginia Anglers Club Bids Farewell to Ukrop's Golden Awards Program

After innumerable years of participation in the Ukrop's Golden Awards Program, the Virginia Anglers Club will no longer seek money from this source. Participation in the Awards program has become complex to the point that the Board felt the \$100 dollars or so received each year from the program is not worth the effort now needed to participate. To participate, the Club would have to establish an account into which funds coming to the club would be transferred quarterly. A member wishing to donate to a club (or any other) account now has to make a request each quarter via e-mail to Ukrop's requesting that funds in the member's program account be transferred to the club account. The Robinson Family can now retire as the club family with the highest level of participation in the program over the past years.

With just 2 more weeks left in the 2006 angling year, the competition is heating up between **Elly Robinson** and **Fred Cousins** for the Kinnard Angler of the Month. Elly took the lead with a sweep in August and a first place in September to give him what appeared to be a commanding lead. Fred was not conceding defeat, so at the October meeting, he took third place with a 2-12 lb spotted seatrout on 2# spin for 183 points, and first place with a 13-0 Gar on 2# plug for 472 points. These points gave Fred the lead with 2592 points. Elly is a close second with 2423 points. Elly is not giving up and has another good entry for the November meeting and I'm sure Fred is also out fishing try to maintain his lead. **Larry Allen** took 2nd place with a 2-12 lb spotted seatrout on 2# spin for 183 points. It was a close race this month with 6 AOM entries and ties for 2nd and 4th places, with the date of the catch breaking the ties.

Mike Ostrander started things off in late October with an 8-0 largemouth bass on 6# spin for 320 points. This was from

private pond fishing from the bank. That same week, **Lynn Spurlin** was at 18 mile Creek in New York fishing for salmon and trout. Lynn caught a 14-0 lb brown trout on 12# fly for 380 points. While Lynn was in New York fishing, **Steve Luterek** left NY and came to Virginia for the VAC membership meeting and some fishing. Steve fished with **Mike Ostrander** and caught several nice flathead catfish, with his best entry being an 18-0 lb on 4 general for 216 points. Remember the "deer in the headlight look" that the new members have when they attend their first membership meeting and they listen to the "Fishing Lies" segment of the meeting. They're thinking to themselves "how could you possibly catch fish that large on line that small". Well Steve has come along way in just 1 1/2 years as a member, going from fishing with 20 and 30 lb for 5 pound walleye and trout in Lake Ontario, to now catching 15-20 pound flatheads on 4 lb test. The gar action has heated up with some pretty outstanding catches. Elly lead the pack with a 14-0 on 2# plug for 509 pts, **Eddie Johnston** entered a 10-0 on 2# plug for 363 pts, and **Scott Johnston** catching a club record 14-8 lb gar on 16# plug for 158 points.

Elly had numerous entries on specks at Lynnhaven inlet with a 2-7 lb on 2# plug for 162 points his best. **Robbie Robinson** picked up 1-2 lb flounder on 2# fly for 117 points on one of these specks trips. **Victor Skakandy** fished Back River in Hampton to catch a 3-4 lb speck on 4# spin for 162 points. **Ross Holsclaw** and **Bob Shepherd** fished Hungers Creek and Ross caught a nice 3-5 lb speck on 8# spin for 110 points. **Wilson Nobles** and **Larry Allen** were fishing the Piankatank River and Wilson entered a 3-6 lb on 4# spin for 168 points and Larry entered the fish that took 2nd in the AOM competition. They had a lot of specks, and from what I heard, lost some really big ones. The specks are still around as **Dean Winsted** and **Jeff Doughty** had some nice catches this week before the storms.

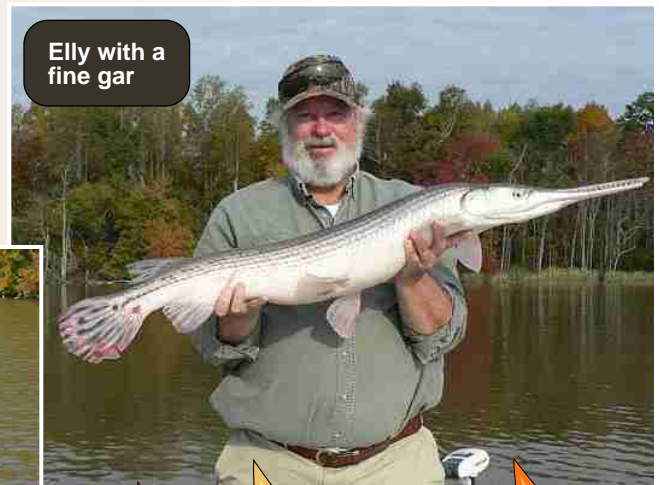

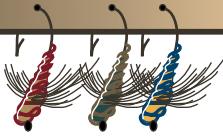

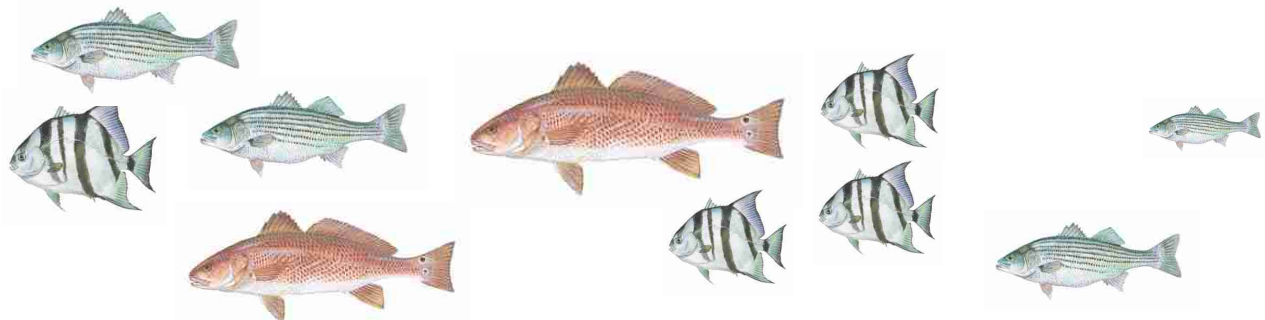

VAC Surf Fishing Team: Champions of the 49th Cape Hatteras AC Surf Tournament

For each of the 45 years of the Virginia Anglers Club existence, a team from the Club has been entered in the Cape Hatteras Anglers Club Invitational Surf Fishing Tournament. Victory has been an elusive catch until this year. This year, the famous Lighthouse Trophy belongs to the Virginia Anglers Club Surf Fishing Team. These guys WON the largest surf fishing tournament in the world, according to the Guinness Book of World Records, besting the other 119 teams.

The Club Surf Fishing Team was lead by Captain Lynn Spurlin this year. Ray Nuckols (who has fished the tournament in all but 3 of the previous 30 years), Gary Martell and Quent Corbett were the other member anglers. Quent's brother Billy Corbett and brother-in-law Tom Johnson rounded out the 6-man team. The wind was up, the surf rolled and the water was dark and murky. Not the best of fishing conditions to say the least. These six guys were tough and focused.

The Thursday morning session got off to a slow start with 2 fish netting a disappointing 5 points. In the afternoon, King Neptune smiled on the team by offering up 61 fish for 198 points. Thursday's 203 points put the VAC Surf Team in third place. The team won Thursday's afternoon session trophy for the highest number of points scored in that session.

The fishing session that clinched the victory was Friday morning. Gary got into a small pocket of puppy drum and pulled four of the eight pups caught that morning. Three of the other four pups caught were scorable. These 7 puppy drum and 8 other scorable fish were worth 167 points. It turned out that these 167 points put the team in an unbeatable position. The afternoon session yielded 1 fish worth 3 points. The Virginia Anglers Club Surf Fishing Team's total tournament winning point count was as 373 points. The second place team was petty well back in the spray with 331 points.

In 2004, the Virginia Anglers Club Surf Fishing Team placed 56th out of 100-contestant teams in the 2004 Cape Hatteras Angler's Club Invitational Surf Fishing Tournament. In 2005, the team finished 41st out of an expanded field of 120 contestant teams. This year the tournament belongs to the Virginia Anglers Club Surf Fishing team who won this prestigious tournament by a respectable number of points.

The Cape Hatteras Anglers Club was founded in 1957 by 81 charter members. The stated purpose of the newly found club was to "stimulate tourism" in the fall season by sponsoring a surf-fishing tournament. The founding was three years after the establishment of the Cape Hatteras Seashore National Park.

1. **New Saltwater Fish Almaco Jack and Blueline Tilefish. Basic Weights –**

2. **Proposal to Eliminate the Practice of “Uplining”**
– defeated by vote of 2 to 4, with Johnston and Noland voting for elimination
3. **Proposal to add 16 and 20 lb. categories where absent in freshwater but present in saltwater.**
(Adding 16 and 20 lb fly; and 20 lb. general for specific fish)
(see page 9 in this issue of the *Angler*)
4. **Change paragraph four in #11 Entry Cards to read:**
A change to a submitted card must be approved by the Angling Rules Committee. By Submitting an entry card.....

The Angling Rules Committee (Danny Noland, Bill DuVal, Scott Johnston, Elly Robinson, Glenn Carter & Stuart Lee) met Wednesday October 18. The following items were discussed and voted on and all items passed unanimously, unless otherwise indicated.

1. **Requirements for Master Angler Rating**
...the member must enter three (3) eligible species, each worth 150 points in each of the following six (6) categories.....

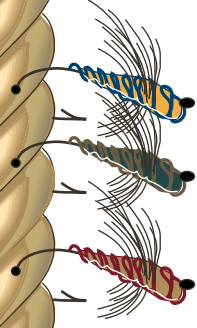
2. **5 c. – Permitted Lines and Tippetts**

Line class is determined by the manufactures’ stated test. It should be noted that some manufactures will purposely understate the advertised test and these lines are NOT permitted. (For example the line label states the line is 12 lb. test., but the manufacturer also states that the line tests at something greater than 12 lbs.)

The use of wire, either braided or solid, and multifilament line (such as PowerPro or Spiderwire) as a running line is prohibited. Dacron is permissible.
