President's Message

Howdy Virginia Anglers Club,

In keeping with the spirit of the President's Letter and the theme I gave myself when writing the President's Letter for the last issue of *The Angler*, I will again write a letter about a President. In this episode, we will be examining Grover Cleveland.

Born on March 18, 1837, Grover Cleveland would become the 22nd and 24th President of the United States (1885-1889, 1893-1897). He had a lifelong love for fishing, especially fly fishing, and would often go fishing as therapy to get away from the pressures of being President. He was a great defender of fishermen who were thought of at the time to be lazy, bent for profanity, and dishonesty. Imagine that! He referred to American fishermen as the "virtuous backbone of the country" and even wrote an article for *The Post* entitled "Defense of Fishermen".

Cleveland wrote many articles about fishing and hunting for the Saturday Evening Post and even penned a book titled "*Fishing and Shooting Sketches*," which is still available today. After leaving the White House, President Cleveland spent his time fishing in upstate New York in summer, Florida in the winter, and writing articles. My favorite Grover Cleveland quote goes like this; "Fishing is good for the soul and good for the country." Crazy to think how important a quote from 130 years ago applies to us today. Just go fishin'

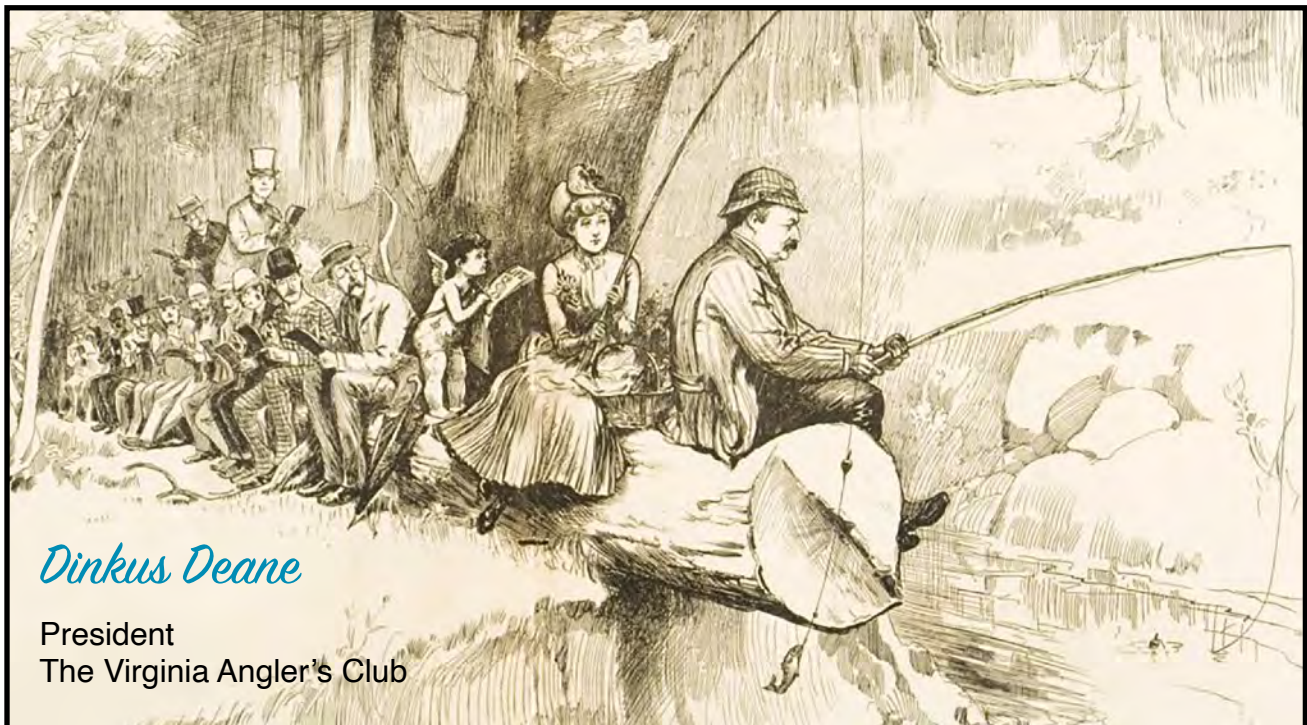

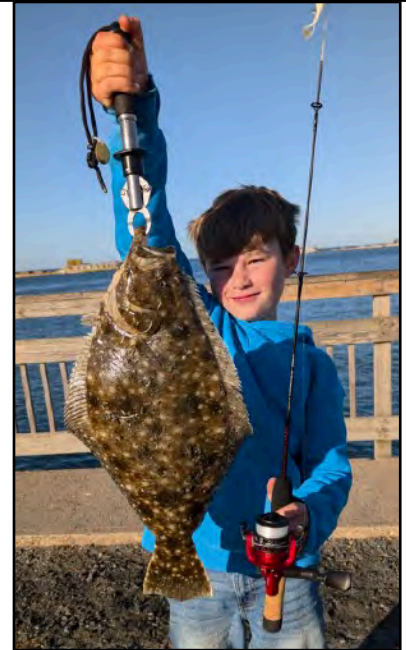

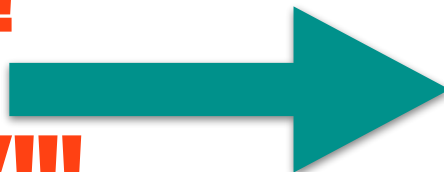
